Advent and Fasting

We hear about Fasting mostly during the Lenten season leading up to Easter.

The liturgical calendar starts at Advent. That is where we are right now. We are in a season of waiting. Ginger shared some of her story of waiting in our article for the month.

When we hear about fasting, most of us immediately think of food, however fasting can be forgoing anything of your choosing. I think when we look at scripture fasting is in regards to sustenance. Abstaining is in regards to other things you are forgoing.

So as we walk through this Advent season we ask that you will join us in a time of fasting or abstaining on the Saturday before our Soup Lunch. We ask that you choose one thing; whether that be food, sugar, technology, social media, etc. to forgo starting on Saturday, December 20.

We will end our fast together on Sunday, December 21 at our soup lunch following service.

During this time we ask that you spend focus time praying for Deep Creek for the following things:

- Opening our hearts and arms to our intermediate pastor
- Our search for a full time pastor
- Ministry and Counsel as they head this search
- Our search for a student minister
- Christian Education Committee as they head this search
- That Deep Creek will be a place of peace and outreach for the community

Our time of fasting is very short, but we want to leave you with this scripture from Matthew 6:16-18.

"And when you fast, do not look gloomy like the hypocrites, for they disfigure their faces that their fasting may be seen by others. Truly, I say to you, they have received their reward. But when you fast, anoint your head and wash your face, that your fasting may not been seen by others but by your Father who is in secret. And your Father who is in secret with reward you."

Fasting is not about the reward, it is about the relationship. It is a tool that allows us to draw nearer to Christ. We hope that you will join us in this time and we look forward to breaking our fast together at our soup lunch on December 21st.
