Blessed be the Little Children

I've been pondering the idea of encouraging young parents for some time; I suppose it's because as a church we are blessed with several parents with young kids. I would like to tell you a story about allowing kids to follow their passions and to encourage you that good things will happen over which you have very little control—blessings from the Lord Himself.

This particular story is about my daughter, Gwyn. Even when she was a small child I knew that she was going to be very musical. Before she could talk she would be playing and would hum to herself and sing. In elementary school she asked if we would buy her a clarinet; it turned out to be a very good investment! She practiced on her own—something her mom and I never did when we played in the band. In high school she made the All-District Band and met a girl there from Mr. Airy, along with her parents. Cathy and I enjoyed meeting them and found out that the girl was also going to attend Salem College. Wake Forest allows other local college students to play in their marching band, a "shared experience" program, and both girls were planning to join the WFU band. Since they both had to attend band camp when it started a week before the other students arrived at Salem, those two were assigned to room together. They hit it off so well that they stayed as roommates for all four years of college.

One song in the Wake band's halftime show was a song by the country band Rascal Flatts. That was Gwyn's favorite musical group at the time. Someone in the music department at Wake Forest knew one of the members of Rascal Flatts. So when Rascal Flatts had a concert in the Greensboro Coliseum the Wake Forest band was asked if they would consider playing onstage with them. Of course the band director said yes. So Gwyn got to play in a concert with her favorite band; how cool is that! Poor Jared, whom she was dating at the time, had bought her tickets to that concert as a special gift, but he didn't even get to sit with her because she was up on the stage with Rascal Flatts.

If I hadn't seen all these things for myself, I wouldn't have believed they could happen. We pray for our kids, but sometimes God has even bigger and better things for them than we pray for. My point is this: Let children follow their God-given dreams and abilities and good things will come together. As Psalm 139:16 NLT says, "You saw me before I was born. Every day of my life was recorded in your book. Every moment was laid out before a single day had passed."
