How did Impact Yadkin really IMPACT Yadkin County?

The numbers reflect hours of planning and organizing by Magnify Ministries, with significant financial investment, plus days, weeks, and months of plain ol' hard work. And the figures glorify our God, who is the author and provider for an amazing experience with eternal results.

The numbers:

- 1,123 participants representing 37 churches
- 52 jobs completed by 45 construction crews
- 8 Party in the Park sites with an overall average of 306 kids each day
- 49 salvation decisions
- 27 young people professing a call into full-time Christian service

Only our Lord could anoint and equip believers to do this work then bless it so beautifully and prolifically!

We are so thankful for the two young people who represented Deep Creek out there on the work teams--in all that heat and humidity! (Katie Mae McDonald and Nathan Boyce, we praise God for you!) There were also people serving behind the scenes at churches all over the county to feed the workers. We on the food crew here prepared lunches Sunday through Friday for two of the crews working in our community. We were in familiar surroundings with plenty of air conditioning and it often seemed we were far from the "real work" and action. But Jesus promised in Matthew 10:42, "...If anyone gives even a cup of cold water to one of these little ones who is my disciple, truly I tell you, that person will certainly not lose their reward." And we had men and women who served faithfully all week. We had helpers ranging in age from 9 to 93 years old! Some folks came in on their only days off work or back in town to help prepare meals. Another who could have been vacationing to celebrate retirement joined the food team instead. One worker made cakes and served the three days before she was scheduled for surgery and others missed helping only for doctors' appointments. Truly, *"The people had a mind to work."* (Neh. 4:6) Then there were those who couldn't be there in person but cooked and baked and delivered all kinds of desserts and side dishes and snacks. In fact, halfway through the week we had to tell our people to stop sending in food for the teams! Just like Moses had to call off donations for building the tabernacle in Exodus 36:3-7, *"And so the people were restrained from bringing more, because what they already had was more than enough to do all the work."*



The week was a blessing to us down in the meeting house basement in so many ways!

We enjoyed the fellowship with the young people and their adult leaders. We finally realized we were missing a great blessing by not sharing in the teams' devotions after their meals, so we started joining them to worship and testify; cleaning up could wait! The Lord increased our bond as sisters and brothers in Christ as well: *"How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity!"*

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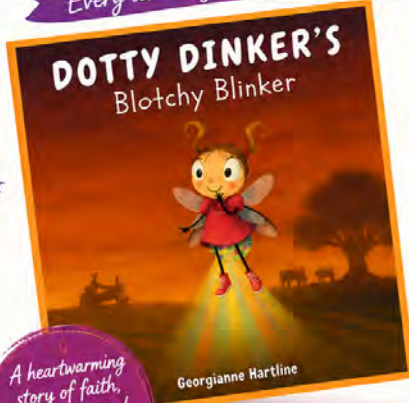
